Flutist Leone Buyse is Professor of Flute at Rice University's Shepherd School of Music. In 1993 she relinquished her position with the Boston Symphony to pursue a more active teaching and solo career. The only American finalist in the 1969 Geneva International Flute Competition, Ms. Buyse has appeared as soloist with l'Orchestre Suisse Romande, Boston Symphony, San Francisco Symphony, among others. She has presented recitals and master classes in the Americas, Europe, and Asia. She may be heard with orchestra and as solo and chamber musicians on recordings for several labels, including Philips, Deutsche Grammophon, CRI, Centaur, Elektra/Nonesuch. Ms. Buyse will perform a solo recital of music from Telemann to Fruehwald, present a session on stage presence: "Owning the Stage," and conduct a master class at IFF.



Composer and flutist Robert Fruehwald is been professor of Composition at Southeast Missouri State University. He studied flute with Francis Fuge and composition with Morton Subotnik, Leonard Roseman, and Dan Welcher. Dr. Fruehwald's compositions include works for large ensembles, chamber music, and extensive writing for flute. In 2006, he published *New Music for Solo Alto and Solo Bass Flute*, a collection of works by himself and other composers. *Hymntunes VII, In Memorium Marie Mountain Clark*, will be premiered by Leone Buyse on her solo recital at Flute Fest. Fruehwald will also present a clinic on his compositions for flute.
