**SUBJECT:** Faculty Scholarship Award

The committee is seeking nominations for the Harry I. Wolk Scholarship Award. The purpose of this award is to encourage scholarship by publicly recognizing and rewarding its creation.

**Eligibility:** To be eligible the faculty person must have taught classes in the college for at least three years and not received the award within the past five years.

**Criteria:** Nominees will be judged on the basis of quality and quantity of their research at Drake University. Any creative endeavor that would normally be considered for tenure and promotion decision in the College is eligible for consideration. Items submitted in support of a nomination must have appeared within five years of the deadline for the award for which the person has been nominated.

**Nominations:** Individuals may be nominated by anyone in or outside the College of Business and Public Administration. Self-nominations are welcome.

**Deadlines:** All material in support of a candidate's nomination, including copies of research, letters of support, published findings, and so forth are due to the chairperson of Promotion and Tenure Committee: Doug Hillman, by February 23, 2007. The candidate will normally be recognized at the Business Days event.

**Selection Committee:** The Promotion and Tenure committee will serve as the selection committee and will review and choose the award recipient from among those individuals nominated.
