## **Drake Administered**

- Semester Cohort Programs: DU Spain & DU England
- J-term Faculty-led Programs: Travel Seminars (locations vary each year)

## **Exchange/Direct Enroll**

- More independent option with institutional partner abroad
- Locations include Australia, Austria, Chile, China, Japan, Mexico, South Africa, & Spain

## **Affiliate**

- Study abroad organizations, aka: "providers"
- Support from provider staff & local university
- Locations worldwide

## Short-term

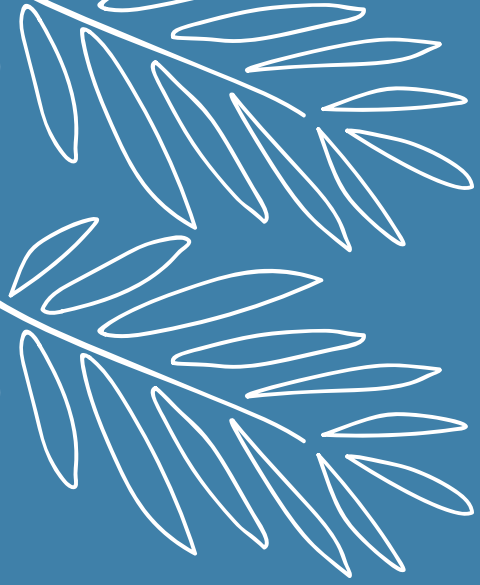
“Sticker Price” from provider  
Typically includes tuition, housing, activities, insurance, and on-site support.

## Semester



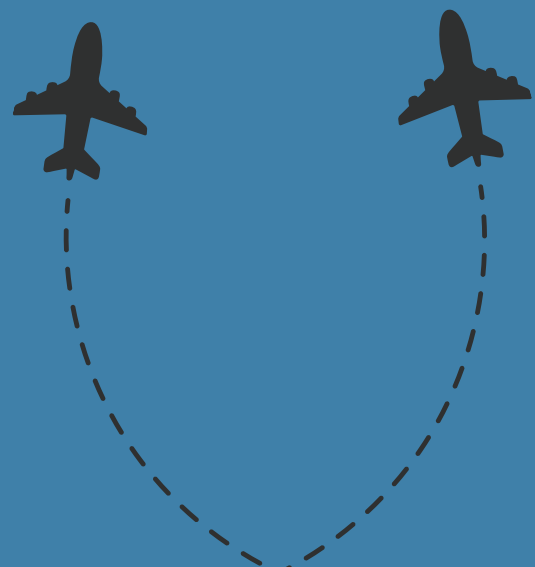
Pay Drake tuition while receiving 100% of your institutional financial aid and scholarship
